

Information

The National indoor championships are to be held in conjunction with the NQAA indoor championships.

The event is also going to be held in conjunction with the 3rd 'World Indoor Archery Challenge' with archers from overseas also competing, thus making it part of an international event.

Competitors scores will, where-ever possible, be uploaded to the AA indoor website at the completion of each flight (*30 arrows*). After the scores from each RGB has been received the results will be available on the same site.

Medals – AA and NQAA

Australian and North Queensland Championship medals will be awarded to the archers with the top 3 scores in each division where there are more than 3 entrants. For divisions with only 3 entrants Gold and Silver only be awarded, and for divisions with less than 3 entrants Gold only will be awarded.

Round

All archers will shoot a double Fita I (*2 x 60 arrows at 18m with compound divisions scoring only the inner 10 as a 10*). Competitors may nominate to use either a 3-spot or a conventional (*single*) 40cm face.

Note that AA rules for this event are now such that archers from other RGBs can compete in their home RGB championships while actually shooting this event in a venue in another RGB, so if you are going to be shooting this event interstate please let us know so we can make arrangements with that other RGB.

Entry Requirements

This is a FITA registered event, so please note that competition in the AA indoor championships is open only to members affiliated with AA and competition in the NQAA indoor championships is open only to members affiliated with NQAA.

WIAC Competition

Please note the important change made by the AA organising committee this year **for the WIAC part of the competition ONLY** - this will be run to FITA rules, with FITA 'classes' applying, hence there are no Cub or Intermediate divisions in the WIAC side of the competition, Cubs and Intermediates will compete as 'Cadets', and there are also no Veteran divisions, Veterans will be competing as 'Masters' (*as per FITA rules*).

In addition, Longbow and Barebow recurve competitors will be competing in the recurve division - Barebow Compound and Crossbow will not be competing in the WIAC part of the competition as these are not recognised in FITA rules.
